

Summer Camp FAQs

Where does Arts Alive! Summer Camp take place?

Camp will take place at St. John's Episcopal Church at 191 County Road across from the Barrington Shopping Center. Look for Arts Alive! sign & staff for check in.

What are the Camp Hours? And, is there an extended day option?

Please arrive between 8:45 and 8:55am (there will be no supervision prior to 8:45). Camp will begin promptly at 9am and will end at 3pm. There is NO extended day option in the morning or afternoon.

What is the pick-up/ drop-off process?

Two staff members will be outside during the drop-off/ pick-up times in order to check students in. We also ask that during this process, all parents and guardians remain in the car and do not walk up to the drop-off areas. Please look for signs.

Do I need to provide lunch for my child at camp?

Yes, all Campers should bring a lunch and water/ drinks daily for camp. PLEASE MAKE SURE ALL FOOD ITEMS ARE PEANUT FREE. Popsicles will be provided daily. Sharing of food is strictly prohibited.

What should my camper wear daily?

Students should wear comfortable closed toed shoes (we will be dancing).

What other items will my camper need? (*We suggest putting items in a labeled Ziploc bag.)

- Water bottle
- Snacks
- Hand Sanitizer
- Towel to sit on outside
- Sunblock
- Bug Spray
- Folder
- Pencil
- Markers/ Crayons
- Glue stick
- Craft scissors



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Will concessions be sold during the camp day?

Yes, concessions will be sold. Items such as chips, candy, cookies, and more will be available for purchase for \$1-\$2. If your child would like to purchase concessions, please send them to camp with money to do so.

Does my child need to bring money for anything else?

Yes, the Del's Lemonade truck will come to camp on Thursdays afternoons, and campers may to bring money to purchase a lemonade if they choose.

Is there an end-of-week performance?

Yes, all Camp weeks conclude with an end-of-week performance for families at *3pm on Friday*. Performances are either held at St. John's Church (If the weather allows, we will hold an OUTDOOR performance in the field. Otherwise, Friday performances will be held in the main hall). Performances may also be held at the Barrington Public Library Salem Auditorium. Your child's performance location will be communicated to you at the start of the session.

Do I need to purchase or provide costumes for the performance?

We ask that campers provide their own costumes/ accessories from home for their performance. Campers will not be asked to purchase any costume items. We will notify you midweek about what colors/ items we would like campers to bring in/ wear for their performance.

What are the protocols if my camper gets sick while at camp?

Parents will be notified by phone or email if a camper gets sick while at camp.
